

PUBLIC LICENSE FOR UNIFIED CHART OF ACCOUNTS (Ver. 1.1)

The Unified Chart of Accounts (UCOA) is a chart of accounts cross-referenced to IRS Form 990 and other uniform reporting standards for nonprofit organizations, together with related designs, concepts, and tools. The CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF NONPROFITS, a California corporation ("CAN"), and the National Center for Charitable Statistics ("NCCS") are holders of the UCOA copyright.

The purpose of this License is to promote the free use of the UCOA by the public and to increase the likelihood of the UCOA being widely accepted and used in the nonprofit sector.
